Coronavirus As you may already be aware the Coronavirus (Covid-19) is now present within the UK. We are putting in place temporary measures to keep everyone safe in line with government guidance:

- The Head Office building has been closed until further notice (office phones have been redirected).
- Office landline (0115 948 277) and on Call manager phone (07490 977 422) will be answered 24/7.
- Office Mobile Phones (07897 341 704 and 07801 164 216) will be answered from 07:00 AM to 11:00 PM.
- Staff have been issued with additional personal protective equipment and hand sanitiser (as shown by a senior carer). Additional supplies of PPE will be dropped off at clients properties
- We will be phoning you on a weekly basis between visits to see how you are doing and check whether you need further assistance.
- Care staff rotas will be structured to minimise travel and cross contract between different groups of clients.
- All staff have had Coronavirus (Covid-19) and infection control training and are working government guidelines.
- Staff are minimising contact and travel outside of work.
- All staff will be monitored closely for symptoms of Coronavirus (Covid-19).
- Join us clapping for front line staff on Thursdays at 08:00 PM!
